Derian gets thumbs-up in family survey

AN independent survey of families at Derian House found that they are "very satisfied" with services and likely to recommend to others.

The research, carried out by DJS Research in

September 2022, was designed to capture open and honest feedback and to see how services at the hospice could be improved.

A total of 100 families who currently use Derian House, and eight bereaved families, took part – a sample chosen independently.

They described staff as "friendly" and "supportive" with 95% of those who responded rating their overall experience as "good" or better.

One family said: ""Excellent! Everything is excellent. 10/10 all round. They cannot do enough for my son.



If all the services were like Derian, I'd be a very happy mummy!"

Another commented: "The help they give you pre and post is phenomenal. I am a nurse myself, and they go well above and beyond."

When asked to suggest improvements, most families said they would like more respite days, more flexible drop off and pick-up times and better communication around events. Some families expressed frustration around the respite booking system and wanted more flexibility around choosing dates.



People said they liked what was on offer, but it was how the services were delivered that really made the difference. One family said: "The staff are so nice, you trust them with your child. That's not easy to do anyway, but when your child has additional needs, it can be hard."

An action plan has been made following the research which includes:

- Better communication with families (including this regular newsletter!).
- Plans for a new family-focused section of the Derian House website.
- Find out why families cancel stays at Derian to help us offer more support.
- Inviting families who joined during the pandemic for an open day to learn more about services available.

Some issues raised had already been tackled, including a more flexible respite booking system which is now in place.
